Ray White Rural Sale Results

Numbers increased for a total of 2951hd today at Dalby. This saw a full panel of buyers today with the return of a major export buyer as well. Today showed that the market has no limits, when you thought cattle can't get any dearer, today showed otherwise. A limited number of export cattle were yarded, and all fields from export, feeders through to weaners all sold extremely well. Heavy cows reached 335c/kg and bulls topped at 350c/kg. Feeder steers along with feeder heifers were in high demand with steers reaching 548c/kg and heifers making 508c/kg. A large panel of buyers were present and strong on the weaner market, with angus weaner heifers topping at 676c/kg and weaner steers reached a top of 678c/kg.
