Ray White Rural Sale Results

Cattle numbers reduced for a total yarding of 4094hd, with over 2100hd yarded in the first round. Today saw a mixed yard of cattle, with a large number of cows yarded again. The cow market slightly eased, which was a result of a large yarding of old store cows that was on offer. Best pen of cows reached 391c/kg. Heavy bulls topped at 378c/kg. A very limited line up of weaners/light feeders to quote on. Light feeder steers reach 608c/kg. Weaners steer topped at 678c/kg. Feeder heifers topped at 542c/kg. Angus weaner heifers sold to a strong panel of buyers, reaching 632c/kg.
