Ray White Rural Sale Results

Today the Dalby cattle sale saw a larger yarding with a total of 5056hd. Overall the market remained firm; there may have been a slight change in the feeder market due to the quality that was yarded. Heavy cows still sold strong selling for a top of 390c/kg. Heavy bulls topped at 378c/kg. Angus feeder steers reached 548c/kg. The weaner market saw no change even with the dry weather approaching very quickly. Weaner steers topped at 700c/kg and heifers reached 630c/kg.
