Ray White Rural Sale Results

Numbers in Dalby reduced this week, yarding 4322hd. All the usual buyers were in attendance, along with a few local restockers. The cow market was 5-10c/kg cheaper although there were a few pens of cows that reached 380c/kg. Heavy bulls remained similar to last week along with full mouth bullocks. Into the feeder/weaner market, there was an improvement of 5-15 c/kg with light feeder steers topping at 580c/kg. Feeder heifers topped at 500c/kg. Weaner steers made a top of 723c/kg and heifers reached 618c/kg.
