Ray White Rural Sale Results

Today at the weekly Dalby cattle sale we saw a smaller yarding for a total of 2433hd. Earlier in the week saw some much needed rain with falls ranging between 10-80mm measured in places. Today's market was red HOT with all areas improving, with the largest improvement seen across little weaner steers. Ray White Rural Dalby sold a run of these steers which reached 766c/kg. Heavy cows improved 10c/kg to top at 390c/kg. Heavy limousin bull topped at 400c/kg and averaged at 365c/kg. Weaner heifers also sold to a dearer trend reaching 698c/kg.
