Ray White Rural Sale Results

Once again this week we saw good widespread rainfall across the Darling Downs region. This did not deter vendors to increase this week's yarding to 4120hd. Today's market was on par with previous weeks, a single high yielding bull and cow topped the export market at 422c/kg. Limited heavy export cows were on offer to average 387.6c/kg. The feeder steers sold extremely well, with the highlight being euro cross steers averaging 340kg topping at 658c/kg. Very limited lightweight steers yarded with the best of them making over 7 dollars! Weaner steers lost 5c/kg to average 653c/kg. Weaner heifers this week have sold to a slightly softer market to average 655c/kg.
