Ray White Rural Sale Results

Total yarding reduces this week for a total of 3711hd. With a smaller yarding of cattle the market was RED HOT. Heavy cows increased by 10 c/kg to top at 410c/kg. Meatworks bulls sold to a similar trend to top at 390c/kg. Young bullocks once again sold very well, with a few new faces on the buying panel the bullocks topped at 450c/kg. Feeder steers averaged 535c/kg with the best pens reaching 570c/kg. A pen of little weight charolais steers topped the weaner steer market, to reach a high of 800c/kg. Feeder heifers were also firm with lines of good quality flat back heifers reaching 540c/kg. Angus weaner heifers reached 692c/kg.
