Ray White Rural Sale Results

With plenty of widespread rainfall throughout the darling downs and surrounding areas, we saw the yarding this week reduce by 1069hd for a total yarding of 2642hd. Heavy cows sold very strong topping at 422c/kg, 12c/kg better than last week. Heavy bulls sold to the same trend to be 15c/kg dearer topping at 405c/kg. Bullocks were no different, also increasing by 20c/kg reaching 468c/kg. Feeder steers sold to a slightly softer market to top at 602c/kg to average 551c/kg. Feeder heifers were once again firm topping at 590c/kg to average 548c/kg. Weaner steers topped at 710c/kg averaging at 669.3c/kg. Weaner heifers topped at 690c/kg same as last week to average 594.8c/kg
