Ray White Rural Sale Results

Today at the Dalby Cattle Sale we saw a decrease in numbers by 1281hd for a total yarding of 3727hd. Heavy cows and bulls this week sold to a slightly softer trend with the best of the cows making 410c/kg and the best of the bulls making 373c/kg. Bullocks also sold to a slightly softer market reaching a top of 453c/kg. The feeder market was really strong with steers reaching 680c/kg, 40c/kg dearer than last week with the feeder heifers also up 40c/kg to top at 610c/kg. Weaners were also strong with both steers and heifers up 10-20c/kg from last week with the steers reaching 828c/kg and the heifers reaching 728c/kg. Cows and calves were on par with last week again making a top of \$3650/unit with PTIC cows making a top of \$2675/head.
