Ray White Rural Sale Results

The last sale of the year has seen an increase in numbers by 1087hd to receive a total yarding of 4905hd. Export buyer attendance was not as good as last week, with this we saw heavy cows and bulls selling to a softer trend with the best of the cows making 390c/kg and the best of the heavy bulls making 344.2c/kg. Bullocks sold very well reaching a top of 492.2c/kg. Feeder steers have remained firm making a top of 648.c/kg with the feeder heifers following the same trend to make a top of 538.2c/kg. The weaner market was once again strong with steers topping at 842.2c/kg and the lightweight heifers topping last week's price by 20c/kg to top at 770c/kg. Cows and calves sold to a dearer trend this week topping at \$4200/unit.
