Ray White Rural Sale Results

This week's yarding in Dalby increased by 2489hd from last week, for a total of 4255hd. Once again, a few major exports were not in attendance which saw the fat cows remain 20-30c/kg cheaper compared to 2021. Top pen of cows reached 366c/kg. Heavy bulls were also easier with limited buyers, reaching 350c/kg. Export feeders were slightly cheaper, but the trade feeders were very firm if not slightly dearer. A run of light trade Simmental steers and feeders were the highlight of the sale. The steer portion making 756c/kg and 8 pens of the heifers topped at 744c/kg. A run of light condition brahman, brahman cross steers that had come from the NT topped at 760c/kg for a 180kg animal.
