Ray White Rural Sale Results

The first sale back from a week off due to a public holiday for Australia day has seen a decrease in numbers by 820hd to receive a total yarding of 3435hd. There has been a return in all major export buyer prices for heavy cows and bulls. These prices have increased by 20-25c/kg with the top pen of cows reaching 385c/kg and the best of the bulls topping at 360c/kg. The rest of the market followed the same trend with most classes all improving. Bullocks were slightly dearer this week topping 452c/kg. The feeder market was firm with yearling feeder steers topping at 716c/kg while the heifers topped at 627c/kg. Weaners were no different with steers increasing by 15c/kg to top at 834c/kg while the heifers remained on par with the previous sale to top at 732c/kg. Cows and calves made a top of \$4,500/unit.
