

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 30th March 2022

Ray White Rural Sale Results

With localised flooding in the area, numbers were reduced today at Dalby, for a total yarding of 1414hd. All regular buyers were present, with a majority of the cattle yarded coming from the far western districts. Today's market did remain on a downward trend across most descriptions. Bullocks to processes this week were 10-12c/kg cheaper, reaching 532c/kg. Heavy feeders averaged 5-8c/kg less topping at 555c/kg. Fat cows remained on a downward trend again, reaching a top of 376c/kg to average 358c/kg. Lightweight weaner steers saw a top of 694c/kg for a line of charolais cross steers. The heifer portion of this line topped at 670c/kg.
