

# Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 20th April 2022

## Ray White Rural Sale Results

Smaller yarding of stock this week at the Dalby Cattle Sale with 1,168hd less than last week for a total yarding of 1,581hd. Most of the cattle yarded were from the local supply areas with the exception of 295hd from Western districts. All regular buyers were in attendance and working to a stronger market than previous weeks with most classes improving. The export market saw prices on average lift 5-20c/kg with the best of the cows making 368c/kg and the best of the bulls making 360c/kg.

The feeder market followed the same trend with steers averaging 10c/kg dearer topping at 550c/kg, heifers topped at 522c/kg. Once again weaners to restockers sold well with a pen of lightweight Angus cross steers making 816c/kg, weaner heifers also sold well reaching at top of 762c/kg.
