

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 27th April 2022

Ray White Rural Sale Results

Good yarding of cattle this week at the Dalby Cattle Sale with numbers increasing by 1,201hd for a total yarding of 2,782hd. All buyers were present with the exception of one usual export buyer, a good line up restockers were also present and active. The market was firm following a similar trend as last week with a few classes improving.

The export market improved by 10c/kg on average, heavy cows reached a top of 382c/kg with the best of the bulls reaching 357c/kg. Feeder steers averaged 524c/kg to top at 596c/kg, feeder heifers averaged 448c/kg to top at 522c/kg. Lightweight weaners sold well with some Angus cross steers making 774c/kg, lightweight heifers topped at 686c/kg. A 3 year old Simmental bull made \$5,800/hd in the open auction, Cows and calves topped at \$4,000/unit.
