Ray White Rural Sale Results

Wet day at the Dalby weekly Cattle Sale today, numbers dropped by 1,194hd for a total yarding of 2,338hd. Today saw a full panel of regular buyers plus a good line up of restockers who were all working to a strong market. Most classes lifted in price from previous weeks, the export market held firm with heavy cows reaching 383c/kg and the best of the bulls making 364c/kg. Feeders 400-500kg sold to a dearer trend with steers topping at 604c/kg, heifers in the same weight category made up to 543c/kg. The weaner market followed the same trend with lightweight steers reaching a top of 828c/kg, the lightweight heifers topped at 698c/kg. PTIC Angus cows in the open auction made to \$2,800/head.
