

# Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 1st June 2022

## Ray White Rural Sale Results

The yarding of cattle increased by 1,675hd for a total of 3,403hd yarded. Buyer attendance was good although export buyers were working to a slightly cheaper market however the rest of the market was firm to dearer in places. The export market was 10c/kg easier with the best of the heavy cows this week topping at 383.2c/kg and the best of the bulls topping at 355.2c/kg. The feeder market was firmer this week with a pen of Angus/Angus cross steers making 598.2c/kg, the heifer portion topped at 554.2c/kg. Weaners this week sold very strong with plenty of competition from usual trade buyers and restockers, lightweight weaner steers made upto 826.2c/kg, lightweight weaner heifers also had plenty of support reaching a top of 750c/kg. Cows and calves topped at \$3,650/unit, PTIC cows made to \$2,600/hd.
