

# Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

**Wednesday 8th June 2022**

## Ray White Rural Sale Results

The number of cattle yarded this week has reduced by 1,238hd due to the return of wet conditions across the supply area; a total of 2,165hd were yarded. All buyers were present this week and all were operating, the export market followed a similar trend to last week being slightly softer however lightweight weaners and trade weight steers were very strong. The best of the heavy cows this week topped at 381.2c/kg with the best of the bulls topping at 356.2c/kg. Heavy feeders were 15-20c/kg better with the steer run topping at 610.2c/kg and the heifer portion at 550.2c/kg. Trade weight feeders saw the biggest jump in price with plenty of competition from trade buyers and restockers, a pen of santa steers made 734.2c/kg and the heifers topped at 575.2c/kg. Weaners sold to a dear trend with lightweight steers making 810.2c/kg, heifers followed the same trend to top at 650.2c/kg. The open auction saw cows and calves making to \$3,100/unit and some PTIC heifers making to \$1,825/hd.
