Ray White Rural Sale Results

A total yarding of 3069, which was a change of -1590 from the previous week. One large run of 440 hereford/ black polly cattle from South Australia, there were also cattle from Western Queensland in the sale. Overall the cattle market has eased again compared to the previous weeks. Not all usual buyers were in attendance. Top cows reached 351c/kg to average 336c/kg. Heavy bull 328c/kg which is 12 cent less than the previous week. Weaner market also eased but held up in the top quality weaners, weaners steers top at 700 c/kg being lightweight angus steer, with the average weaner steer reaching 640c/kg. Weaner heifers topped at 600c/kg which is a change of 60c/kg compared to the previous week.
