

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 6th July 2022

Ray White Rural Sale Results

With widespread rain falling across a large part of Southeast Qld, numbers dropped to a total of 2252 - which was a change of 817hd from the previous week. Overall the cattle market has eased slightly in some of the store categories although most kill descriptions remained firm to the previous weeks. Buyers for all classes were in attendance and active. Top cows reached 358c/kg to average 346c/kg. Heavy bulls up to 346c/kg. Feeder steers >400kg made to a top of 534c/kg to avg 508c/kg with the feeder heifer portion >400kg making up to 500c/kg to avg 471c/kg, Trade weight feeder steers 330-400kg making up to 562c/kg to avg 535c/kg with the trade heifer 330-400kg unable to maintain last week's rates to top at 526c/kg to avg 503c/kg. A good quality line of weaner steers 200-280kg topped at 650c/kg to avg 583c/kg. Backgrounder heifers 200-280kg topped at 536c/kg to avg 496c/kg.
