

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 13th July 2022

Ray White Rural Sale Results

Although parts of the state are still fairly wet, vendors were able to get cattle out this week and 4529 cattle were yarded for this week's sale - Up 2277hd from the previous week. Slaughter lines remained firm on last week even though not all buyers were in attendance, all feed descriptions were slightly cheaper. Top cows reached 340c/kg to average 315c/kg. Heavy bulls up to 331c/kg. Feeder steers >400kg made to a top of 500c/kg to avg 482c/kg with the feeder heifer portion >400kg making up to 490c/kg to avg 405c/kg, Trade weight feeder steers 330-400kg making up to 564c/kg to avg 522c/kg with the trade heifer 330-400kg unable to maintain last week's rates to top at 490c/kg to avg 441.3c/kg. Weaner cattle were solid on last week's rates and buyers were very active on quality lines. 200-280kg topped at 648c/kg to avg 554c/kg. Backgrounder heifers 200-280kg topped at 550c/kg to avg 460c/kg.
