Ray White Rural Sale Results

Numbers lifted this week to 3064hd, an increase of 766hd. One major export buyer was absent again though southern buyers were very active in export cattle which saw prices increase. The cow market was once again the hero, with heavy cows reaching 366c/kg. Weaner steers were stronger for the quality lines and heifers saw very little change to previous weeks, with steers topping at 600c/kg and heifers reaching 540c/kg. Trade weights to 518c/kg for the steers and heifers topped at 454c/kg respectively. The heavy feeder portion saw little change with steers reaching 502c/kg and heavy heifers topping at 454c/kg.
