Ray White Rural Sale Results

Numbers this week at Dalby continued to decline due to the ongoing wet conditions, for a total yarding of 2395hd a reduction of 968hd. All descriptions firm to dearer with all processors and a good panel of restockers in attendance and operating. Heavy cows reached 408c/kg and meatworks bulls topped at 415c/kg. Feeder steers topped at 555c/kg and feeder heifers up to 528c/kg. Trade weight steers made to 626c/kg and heifers to 546c/kg. Cattle returning to the paddock remained in high demand with weaner steers topping at 754c/kg and the heifer portion reaching up to 626c/kg. A small selection of cows and calves made up \$2575/unit.
