

# Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 19th October 2022

## Ray White Rural Sale Results

Numbers at Dalby almost doubled the previous weeks level to the highest in the nation this week to 5,075 head. The large panel of export buyers in attendance included southern export processors and all were operating. Light weight yearling steers and heifers returning to the paddock averaged 16c to 30c/kg better. Heavy steers and bullocks to export processors averaged 5c better. Most classes of cows sold to a slightly cheaper market to average 2c to 4c/kg less. Light weight yearling steers returning to the paddock made a top of 766c with a large sample averaging 664c/kg. A few pens of bullocks made 435c/kg. Good heavy cows made up to 397c to average 383c/kg. Heavy weight bulls made 423c/kg.
