

# Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 26th October 2022

## Ray White Rural Sale Results

Recent widespread rain over the past week dropped the cattle supply to 1470hd, a reduction of 3605hd on last week. Slaughter cattle remained firm given the decrease in numbers, lightweight cattle sold to a dearer market for quality lines. Feeder lines also remained firm with heavy steers topping at 524c/kg to avg 460c/kg and heifers reaching 510c/kg. Trade weight feeder steers topped at 688c/kg with heifers making up to 616c/kg. Light weight yearling steers returning to the paddock made a top of 738c with a large sample averaging 685c/kg and the heifer portion topping at 636c/kg.

A small number of bullocks reached 427c/kg and good heavy cows reached 401c/kg.
