

# Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

**Wednesday 30 November 2022**

## Ray White Rural Sale Results

The supply of stock at Dalby experienced a small reduction of 211 head to 4997. Export attendance wasn't as good as the previous week however the regular feed and trade buyers were present. Prices continued to ease for a number of classes with heavy cows experiencing losses of up to 8c/kg and feeder steers up to 20c/kg cheaper with feeder heifers following a similar path. Heavy grown steers to export processors made to 347c/kg to avg 344c/kg.

Medium 2 score cows averaged 265c/kg with good heavy cows averaging 314c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed made to 472c/kg to avg 445c/kg, Heavyweight heifers to feed making 378c/kg to avg 350c/kg. Weaners experienced little change from previous week with only quality related price variations.
