Ray White Rural Sale Results

The number of head at Dalby reduced by 294hd to total 5208. Export buyers were in attendance however not all were operating. Some of the regular feeder operators were not present. Prices across a number of classes could not maintain the levels of the previous week. Lightweight yearling steers and heifers received fair demand for the quality lines though most were 30-40c/kg cheaper. Feeder steers and heifers suitable for domestic feed markets averaged 20-40c/kg less. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed experienced little change to average 454c/kg. All classes of cows sold to a cheaper trend, with good heavy cows down by 20c/kg, heavy bulls holding firm and made to 346c/kg. Bullocks made up to 380c/kg to average 371c/kg.
