

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 7th December 2022

Ray White Rural Sale Results

Numbers this week at Dalby continued the trend of most selling centres with a decline in numbers to total 2587hd. Cattle were drawn from far western QLD and NSW. Heavyweight yearling steers to feed averaged 5c/kg less and topped at 466c/kg to average 441c/kg. Medium weight yearling steers to feed averaged 454c/kg and topped at 552c/kg with heifers in the same category topping at 466c/kg to average 441c/kg. Heavy weight grown steers to export processors averaged 345c/kg and good export cows topping at 310c/kg to average 299c/kg. Heavy bulls sold to similar trends when compared to the previous week. Most lightweight weaners sold to fair demand and rates were similar to previous weeks with steers topping at 652c/kg and heifers to 556c/kg.
