

# Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 14th December 2022

## Ray White Rural Sale Results

Cattle numbers for the last sale at Dalby for 2022 reduced to a total of 1429hd. Most classes experienced good demand with only quality related price changes. Good quality light weight steers returning to the paddock sold to 610c/kg to avg 542c/kg. Yearling steers to feed for the domestic market made to a top of 500c/kg to avg 455c/kg, with a good sample in the same weight range returning to the paddock making 563c/kg. Heavy weight steers to feed made to 466c/kg with an average of 420c/kg. Lightweight yearling heifers made up to 524c/kg for isolated sales with the largest number averaging 448c/kg. Domestic feeder heifers topped at 460c/kg to average 420c/kg. Heavy steers to export processors topped at 354c/kg with the best of the cows topping at 295c/kg. A large number of lightweight bulls to restockers averaged 451c/kg and topped at 602c/kg. We would like to wish everyone a Merry Christmas and Happy and Safe New Year! We will commence sales 11th of January 2023.
