

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 11th January 2023

Ray White Rural Sale Results

The supply of stock for the opening market in Dalby remained relatively low at 1,441 head. A fair line up of buyers were present with some of the regulars absent from the buying panel. Apart from cows experiencing very little change in price from the previous sale, all other classes of young cattle could not maintain the market value of last year. Lightweight yearling steers returning to the paddock made a top of 550c/kg to average 458c/kg and poor quality lines averaged 360c/kg. Yearling steers to feed for the domestic market made up to 470c/kg to average from 431c to 440c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed made to the occasional 420c/kg to average 390c/kg. Light weight yearling heifers returning to the paddock averaged 428c/kg and sold to 464c/kg with the lesser quality lines at 334c/kg. Yearling heifers to feed made up to 441c/kg to average 416c/kg. Heavy weight yearling heifers to trade made to 380c/kg with a good sample at 346c/kg. Medium weight 3 score cows averaged 280c/kg and made to a top of 282c/kg. Good heavy weight cows mostly sold around 303c/kg with sales to 314/kg. Heavy weight bulls made to 317c/kg. Lightweight bulls to restockers made up to 438c/kg to average 405c/kg with poor quality lines from 110c to 220c/kg.
