

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 1st February 2023

Ray White Rural Sale Results

The supply of stock at Dalby increased by 202 head to 3,526. Consignments of 455 head from far Western Queensland and 253 from New South Wales were included in the line up. All the usual export buyers were in attendance and operating on improved prices. Yearling steers and heifers to feed saw very little change in price. However bullocks and cows to export processors have sold to a dearer trend with improvements of 6c to 10c/kg. Light weight feeder steers to feed averaged 405c/kg and sold to 426c/kg. Bullocks made to 367c/kg to average 357c/kg. Cows to restockers made to 313c/kg to average 284c/kg. Good heavy weight cows to export processors made to 308c/kg to average 299c/kg. Heavy weight bulls made to 316c/kg. Weaner steers topped at 588c/kg and weaner heifers topped at 476c/kg.
