

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 15th February 2023

Ray White Rural Sale Results

The continuing hot and dry conditions across a large portion of the usual supply areas increased the number of stock at Dalby by 604 head to 5,373. A large number of cows averaged 3c to 4c/kg cheaper with the top pen of cows reaching 303c/kg. Heavy grown steers and bullocks averaged from 342c to 344c with sales to 358c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed were well supplied with over 900 head penned. A combination of the larger numbers plus some consignments with an average weight of 520kg prices could not maintain the levels of the previous week to average 18c/kg less. Light weight yearling steers returning to the paddock made to 530c/kg with a large number at 483c/kg, lesser quality lines topped 373c/kg. Light weight yearling heifers to restockers made to 448c to average 407c/kg and poor quality lines 328c/kg. Yearling heifers to feed made to 399c to average from 374c to 382c/kg. Heavy grown steers and bullocks averaged from 342c to 344c with sales to a top of 358c/kg. Cows and calves sold from \$1400 to \$2,400/unit.
