

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 22nd February 2023

Ray White Rural Sale Results

The supply of stock at Dalby reduced by 340 head to total 5,033. All the usual buyers were in attendance and active in the market. Well bred light weight yearling steers and heifers returning to the paddock met strong demand however a small slip in quality resulted in a large fall in price. Yearling steers and heifers to feed experienced very little change in price. Bullocks to export processors averaged 10c to 15c/kg less. Light weight yearling steers returning to the paddock made to 532c to average 485c/kg. Yearling steers to feed for the domestic market made to 472c with most from 415c to 431c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed made to the occasional 420c to average 385c/kg. Light weight yearling heifers returning to the paddock made to 482c to average 380c/kg, poor quality lines at 302c/kg. Yearling heifers to feed averaged from 367c to 375c topping 402c and some to restockers made to 416c/kg. Bullocks made to 340c to average 329c/kg. Heavy weight 3 score cows averaged 274c and good heavy weight cows made to 302c to average 288c/kg. Heavy weight bulls made to 302c/kg. Cows and calves made to \$1780/unit.
