

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 8th March 2023

Ray White Rural Sale Results

Dalby cattle numbers reduced by 2,425 head for a total of 3,989. Heavy weight cows sold to good demand and showed a small improvement with the top pen of cows reaching 290c/kg to average 287c/kg. Bullocks averaged 5c/kg less. Grown steers to feed made to 330c to average 325c/kg. A handful of heavy grown steers and bullocks made 322c to average 317c/kg. Medium and heavy weight yearling steers to feed remained firm. Light weight yearling steers under 200kg made to 564c/kg. Yearling steers to put on feed averaged from 399c to 420c and sold to a top of 458c with restockers lines in the same weight range making up to 498c/kg. Light weight yearling heifers to restockers made to 376c to average 340c/kg. Cows and calves made to \$1,620/unit.
