

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 15th March 2023

Ray White Rural Sale Results

The welcomed rain over the weekend saw cattle numbers reduced by 1,084 head to 2,905. Cattle were drawn from a wide area with 506 from far Western Queensland and 385 from New South Wales. Most areas sold to a cheaper trend. Cows to export processors averaged 10c/kg less with the top pen of cows reaching 275c/kg. Bullocks experienced the largest loss overall, averaging 20c/kg cheaper. Charbray bullocks topped the market at 296c/kg. Medium weight yearling steers to feed made to a top of 410c with an average of 380c/kg. Weaners steers sold to similar trends to previous weeks with the best of the weaners steers reaching 502c/kg. A little change in the heifers saw a live export order in the tropical types with the best heifers reaching 370c/kg. Cows & calves sold for a top of \$1750.
