

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 22nd March 2023

Ray White Rural Sale Results

Numbers increased by 791 head to a total of 3,696. Overall, we saw some new buyers from Tambo, Emerald and Dingo helped stabilise prices for younger cattle. Light weight yearling steers returning to the paddock averaging 17c/kg or better. However, with the absence of an Export buyer, saw the side of the market easing. Good heavy weight cows made up to 265c to average 255c/kg. Cows continued to sell to a cheaper market on top of the losses experienced in the previous week with the average prices being 10c to 20c/kg less. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed lost a further 15c/kg. Light weight yearling steers returning to the paddock made to a top of 524c with a good sample averaging 470c/kg. Light weight yearling heifers to restockers made to 316c to average 293c and poor quality lines 259c/kg.
