

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 5th April 2023

Ray White Rural Sale Results

The number of cattle penned at Dalby reduced by 1,845 head to 2,202. The short working week has resulted in reduction of export processors in attendance however, the regular feed and trade buyers plus restocker were present. Heavy weight cows averaged 275c with the best cows making up to 270c/kg. Heavy weight Bulls made to 248c/kg. Yearling steers to restockers and feed were firm to marginally better with yearling heifers improving in places. Light weight yearling steers returning to the paddock made to 506.2c to average 440c/kg. Light weight yearling heifers returning to the paddock made a top of 400c to average 345c/kg. Poorer quality heifers topped at 287c/kg. Yearling heifers to feed averaged from 331c to 339c and made to a top of 366c/kg. Cow and calf units made to a top of \$1800.
