

## **Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report**

## Wednesday 12th April 2023

## **Ray White Rural Sale Results**

The number of cattle penned at Dalby reduced to 1,416 head down 786 from the previous week. All the usual export buyers were in attendance however not all were operating. Light weight yearling steers to restockers averaged 5c/kg dearer. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed were marginally better. Yearling heifers to feed for the domestic market improved by 5c to 10c/kg. Cows gained 2c to 4c/kg better than the previous week. Light weight yearling steers returning to the paddock made up to 501c with an average of 446c/kg. Medium weight yearling steers to feed made to 406c with an average of 363c. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed averaged 346c and made to 365c/kg. Light weight yearling heifers returning to the paddock made 366c/kg to average 339c/kg. Medium weight yearling heifers to feed made to 356c to average from 340c/kg to 342c/kg. Bullocks made to 330c to average 325c/kg. Grown heifers to export processors made to 321c/kg. Medium weight score 2 cows averaged 232c and made a top of 241c/kg. Heavy weight cows made to 277c. Heavy weight bulls made to 271c/kg.
