

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 26th April 2023

Ray White Rural Sale Results

The number of cattle penned at Dalby increased by 2,055 head to 6,875 with the cancellation of some sales due to the public holiday lifting the supply. All the regular operators were present and active in the market. With the large number of cows buyers were able to handle larger supply plus maintaining firm prices. Yearling steers to feed experienced small improvement in places. The better end of the yearling heifers held firm, however poor quality lines were cheaper.

Light weight yearling steers returning to the paddock made to 450c with the large portion being between 405c to 415c/kg. Yearling steers to feed for the domestic market averaged 372c to 390c and topped at 422c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers averaged 352c and made to 374c with some to restockers at 409c/kg Light weight yearling heifers returning to the paddock averaged 311c and made to a top of 374c/kg with the poor quality line making 261c/kg. Yearling heifers to feed averaged from 310c to 324c with a sale topping at 368c/kg. Heavy grown steers made to 331c and bullocks made to 320c to average 318c/kg. Medium weight cows averaged 242c and made to a top of 254c/kg. Heavy weight cows were well supplied with an average of 260c and made to 268c/kg. Good heavy weight cows made to 273c with a large number averaging 269c/kg. Heavy weight bulls made to 320c/kg
