

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 10th May 2023

Ray White Rural Sale Results

The movement of larger numbers of cattle are still continuing to move into the market at Dalby with numbers increasing by 1,199 to 5,086 head. All the regular buyers were in attendance and operating on reduced prices. There was a slight improvement in the weaner steers although unfortunately the weaner heifers were tough to place. Cows lost a further 25c to 30c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed made to a top of 358c with an average of 333c/kg. Heavy weight yearling heifers to feed averaged 278c with a portion making 300c/kg. A large number of full mouth bullocks were penned with sales to average 270c, however the best of the very heavy weights made to a top of 208c/kg. Medium weight poor condition cows averaged 157c and the score 2 cows made 186c/kg. Heavy weight score 3 cows made to 225c to average 212c/kg. The very best of the cows averaged 231c and made a top of 240c/kg. Heavy weight bulls made to 278c/kg.
