

## **Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report**

## Wednesday 14th June 2023

## **Ray White Rural Sale Results**

A total of 3,728 at Dalby which was a small reduction of 220 head to the previous week. Cattle numbers were drawn from Western Queensland, New South Wales and a large majority being from the local areas. Buyer attendance was good with a full panel of export processors as well as the regular feed and trade operators. Plain condition cows to processors averaged 176c and made to a top of 188c. Restockers lines averaged 188c and made to 202c/kg. Heavy weight 3 score cows to export processors averaged 202c and the best of the cows made to 225c to average 216c/kg. Heavy bulls made up to 265c/kg. Grown steers to export processors made to 304c to average 296c/kg. Feeder steers improved 10 to 15c/kg to top at 332c/kg whilst the feeder heifer portion saw strong competition topping at 302c/kg. Weaner classes were tough again with very little new weaner orders. Light weaner steers 200kg reached to 398c/kg with weaner steers over 300kg topping at 360c/kg. Weaner heifers saw prices making from 120c/kg up to 270c/kg quality related.
