

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 21st June 2023

Ray White Rural Sale Results

The supply of stock into Dalby continues to decline with numbers reducing by 571 head to 3,150. All the regular buyers were in attendance and operating. Prices maintain the levels of the previous sale. Heavy weight bulls made to a top of 268c/kg. Grown steers to processors made to 280c and bullocks made to 270c and averaged 267c/kg. The best of the cows made to a top of 215c to average 208c/kg. Heavy weight 3 score cows to processors averaged 189c and made to 200c/kg. Medium weight plain condition cows to restockers averaged 182c and heavy weights 187c with sales to 196c/kg. Feeder Angus, Angus steers sold to a top of 340c/kg with cross breed feeder steers reaching 330c/kg. The weaner steers and light yearling bulls saw an improvement with 2 new buyers in persistent today. Weaner heifers still find it hard to find homes.
