

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 6th September 2023

Ray White Rural Sale Results

The continuing decline in prices reduced the number of cattle at Dalby to 3,375 head, a fall of 1,388 head from the previous sale. Most of the cattle yarded were from local supply however, 673hd traveled from far Western Queensland and 291 head were from New South Wales. Most of the regular export buyers were in attendance and operating selectively, however one major feed and trade buyer was absent from the buying panel. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed averaged 14c/kg less. A better quality lineup of heavy weight yearling heifers to feed experienced a stronger market. Cows were firm to 2c to 7c/kg cheaper. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed made to a top of 296c to average 275c/kg. Heavy weight yearling heifers to feed were not far behind and sold to 288c to average 256c/kg. A handful of bullocks made to 261c to average 260c/kg. Medium weight light condition cows made to 166c to average 149c/kg. Heavy weight 3 score cows averaged 205c and the best of the heavy weights made to 222c to average 217c/kg. Heavy weight bulls made to 246c/kg.
