

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 18th October 2023

Ray White Rural Sale Results

The number of cattle penned at Dalby increased over 1,000 head to 3,550. Majority of buyers were present with two major export buyers absent. Prices experienced some improvement in places with yearling steers to feed firm to marginally better. Medium weight yearling heifers to feed were cheaper whereas heavy weights experienced some improvement. Cows also varied in price with medium weights 5c/kg less and heavy weights remained consistent with the previous week. Medium weight yearling steers to feed made to 234c to average 225c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed averaged 222c and made to 236c/kg. Medium weight yearling heifers to feed made to 206c and averaged 164c/kg. Good condition heavy weight yearling heifers made to 230c and the plainer classes averaged 186c and made to 200c/kg. Medium weight 2 score cows made to 122c to average 120c/kg. Heavy weight 3 scores averaged 153c and the best of the cows averaged 174c and made to 181c/kg. Heavy weight bulls made to a top of 222c/kg.
