Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 12th June 2024

Ray White Rural Sale Results

The supply of stock at Dalby increased by 1,461 head to 4,486. A good sample of 751 head from far Western Queensland and 134 head from New South Wales was included in the lineup along with 3,601 from the local supply areas. Export buyer attendance was good with an additional four processors present plus the regular feed and trade operators. Yearling steers to feed at the time of this interim report have sold to a cheaper trend. Heavy weight yearling heifers also lost ground to average 10c/kg less. Despite the extra buyers in the cow section prices could not maintain the levels of the previous sale and lost 7c to 10c/kg. Medium weight yearling steers to feed made to 332c and averaged 313c/kg. Heavy weight yearling steers to feed made to 331c to average 314c/kg. Heavy weight yearling heifers to feed made to 310c and averaged 287c/kg. The occasional heavy grown steer to export processors made to 298c/kg. Medium weight 2 score cows averaged 183c and made to 191c/kg. Heavy weight 3 score cows averaged 212c and made to 220c and the best of the heavy weight cows sold to 237c to average 227c/kg. Heavy weight bulls made to 260c/kg.
