

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 2nd July 2025

The first sale of the new financial year in Dalby saw numbers reduced by 688 head to 4,638. Export buyer attendance was good, and once again this week, southern exporters provided the most strength across the bullocks and cows. Around 1,200 cows were penned, and over half were purchased by southern exporters. A fair panel of feed and trade buyers were present; however, some of the regulars were absent. Lightweight yearling steers returning to the paddock regained the previous week's losses and improved by 10c to 19c/kg. Yearling steers to feed averaged 9c to 12c/kg better. Lightweight yearling heifers to restockers also regained the losses of the previous sale, with a lift in quality further contributing to the improvement. Heavyweight yearling heifers to feed improved by 12c/kg. Bullocks sold to strong competition, and heavy grown heifers followed a dearer trend. Cows continued to rise in price, averaging 3c to 5c/kg better. Lightweight yearling steers returning to the paddock made to 474c, averaging from 394c to 424c/kg. Yearling steers to feed for the domestic market made to 440c, averaging from 389c to 414c/kg. Heavyweight yearling steers to feed reached a top of 453c, averaging 390c, while lines over 480kg made to 395c/kg. Yearling heifers to restockers made to 356c, averaging from 316c to 324c/kg. Medium weight yearling heifers to feed made to 382c, averaging from 325c to 342c/kg. Heavyweight yearling heifers to feed made to 396c, averaging 342c/kg. Bullocks made to 396c, averaging 366c/kg. Heavyweight grown heifers made to 380c, averaging 358c/kg. Very plain-conditioned medium weight cows sold to restockers at 260c, averaging 257c/kg. Heavyweight PTIC cows sold to restockers at a top of 323c/kg, with some returning \$2,094/head. Heavyweight 3-score cows to processors averaged 296c, and the best of the heavyweight cows made to 344c, averaging 319c/kg. Heavyweight bulls made to 332c/kg.
