

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 25th June 2025

The number of cattle penned at Dalby experienced a slight reduction of 239 head, totaling 5,326. Southern export buyers provided strong competition across the better-quality bullocks and cows; however, not all regular export buyers were in attendance. A good panel of feed and trade buyers, along with restockers, were present and active. Lightweight yearling steers returning to the paddock struggled to maintain the levels of the previous sale, selling to a cheaper market in places. Medium and heavyweight yearling steers to feed experienced only quality-related price changes. Selected lines of lightweight yearling heifers returning to the paddock sold to good demand; however, most other classes sold to a cheaper trend. Medium and heavyweight yearling heifers to feed received very little change. Heavy grown steers and bullocks sold to strong demand. Around 1,300 cows were penned, and buyers were able to absorb the large supply, lifting prices by a further 8c to 12c/kg. Lightweight yearling steers returning to the paddock made up to 452c, averaging from 404c to 412c/kg. Yearling steers to feed for the domestic market made up to 448c, averaging from 404c to 408c/kg. Heavyweight yearling steers to feed reached 434c, averaging 381c/kg. Lightweight yearling heifers to restockers peaked at an isolated 352c, with most sales ranging from 271c to 292c/kg. Medium-weight yearling heifers to feed averaged from 307c to 319c, with sales up to 364c/kg. Heavyweight yearling heifers to feed made up to 363c, averaging 330c/kg. Bullocks reached 393c, averaging 374c, while full-mouth bullocks made up to 336c, averaging 315c/kg, with occasional heavyweight full-mouth bullocks returning \$3,042/head. Heavyweight grown heifers made up to 368c/kg. Medium-weight, very plain condition cows made up to 251c, averaging 234c/kg. Heavyweight 3-score cows averaged 291c, and the best of the heavyweight cows made up to 340c, averaging 316c/kg, with some returning \$2,894/head. Heavyweight bulls made up to 344c/kg.
