

Dalby Cattle Sale Market Report

Wednesday 7 th January 2026

Dalby agents penned 931 head for the first sale of 2026. Most of the usual feeder and restocker buyers were in attendance, along with several processors. Competition was strong, with the market very similar to the prices recorded at the close of 2025. Yearling steers weighing 200-280kg returning to the paddock sold to 536c and averaged 519c/kg, while yearling steers to feed for the domestic market made up to 510c, averaging 509c/kg. Heavy yearling steers to feed sold to 506c and averaged 495c/kg. Yearling heifers weighing 200-330kg to restockers reached 486c and averaged 413c/kg. Yearling heifers to feed for the domestic market sold to 470c, with heavy yearling heifers to feed making 482c and averaging 460c/kg. Young bullocks to processors averaged 430c and sold to 468c/kg, while grown heifers to processors made 436c and averaged 417c/kg. Light weight cows to processors sold to 362c and averaged 300c/kg. Good heavy score 3 cows reached 387c, with the best heavy cows making 390c and averaging 382c/kg. Light weight bulls to feed sold to 416c and averaged 405c/kg, while heavy bulls to processors made 400c and averaged 393c/kg.
