

Get More Out of Your Heating System

Turn it Down

Your heater only needs to be set between 18 and 22°C - anything higher isn't necessary!

Maintain Your Heater

Give your heater a full service. Maintaining your heater helps keep it running at peak efficiency. Clean your filters regularly and service your system professionally.

Switch it Off

Turn the heater off when you're not in the room and don't leave it on overnight.

Timing

If you can set a timer on your heater, set it to turn on for 15 minutes on low before you arrive home, rather than blasting it on high when you arrive.

Add a Fan

You can boost the effectiveness of electric heaters by using the fan function.



Rug Up

Use rugs; They are ideal insulators and also give you a soft surface to walk on. The more floor you can cover, the more insulated your room will be. Timber floorboards and floor tiles can be too cold in winter, but are so cool in summer.

Treat Your Windows

Shutters are great for light control, but they are not the most affordable option.

Curtains are more cost-effective. Block-out fabrics are known to retain warmth and prevent air infiltration, which helps keep interior spaces cosy and comfortable.

Upgrade Insulation

When a home is well insulated, heat is prevented from escaping through the walls, roof, and other surfaces. Not sure whether your insulation needs updating? Firstly, consider that older homes may not have any insulation at all. Secondly, look at your energy bills. Updating your insulation may be an achievable D.I.Y. job, particularly in the ceiling.

Unless you're doing an extensive renovation, retrofitting wall insulation can be a complex task. If you have access to the ceiling and underfloor, insulating these first is recommended.
