# Fishing Report

What great weather and great fishing this time of the year produces in the Hauraki Gulf. Everywhere from The Noises up to and beyond Cape Rodney is holding huge numbers of snapper along the 30m to 50m line. Fishing good also in on the sand, closer in, but the best reports are coming from out wider.

The Fishing Direct team recently went out on a mission off Omaha loaded with all the latest and greatest jigs and lures and a couple of bags of ice. Slight NE wind so head slightly north into it till we decided to investigate the great images we were seeing on the fishfinder. So quick and easy with slow-jigs, just stop the boat and drop your lure. You'll soon find out if your 'on the spot'?

Orange 140gm CoinDrop was the first lure to be deployed, but soon realized the wind needed to be allowed for, so we put out our Tagit Sea Anchor. This made a huge difference allowing us to get 'straight' down to the bottom and to stay at the bottom. I find if you're not 20 degrees either side of vertical your fishing is much reduced, so putting down a heavier jig and using a sea anchor can make a big difference to your days action. With the me on softbaits and the rest of the team on sliders etc the fishing was underway, and



# How to be a Pest Detective this Summer

In the November issue we told the story of Forest & Bird's Pest Free Hibiscus Coast Project, which aims to work with the whole community to create a safe haven for native species along the Whangaparaoa Peninsula and beyond.

During November and December the project is running a "Getting Bites" campaign, which enables local residents to detect pest animals like rats and possums in your backyards using free "chew cards". These simple pieces of corflute infused with a non-toxic peanut scented dough are irresistible to these critters which leave evidence of their presence in the form of distinctive bite marks. All you need to do is order your card and nail it to a tree or post in your garden for a week.

Choose somewhere you might expect rats / possums to visit, eg along the edge of a fence or near compost for rats, or at the base of a large fruiting or flowering tree.

By understanding more about pest animals in your backyard, you can improve your chances of a catch if you already have a trap, or it's a great thing to do before you order one to work out a good location to put it.

Project Manager Jenny Hanwell says "most people have never seen a live rat in their backyard, but that doesn't mean they aren't passing through, we know several residents who have caught a lot of rats in a short space of time, yet never seen any evidence of them".



You can also look out for signs of possums in addition to crush marks on the chew cards. They tear fresh leaves as they consume them, and leave scratches on bark. One possum can eat 3 shopping bags full of leaves, fruits and flowers in one night, plus birds eggs and chicks. The project also has humane tested, pet-safe possum traps available on 6 week loan, highly recommended for those with bush blocks.

The Pest Free Hibiscus Coast project runs predator control across most reserves thanks to the efforts of 100 volunteers, and with funding from Auckland Council. So far this year over 46,000 rats have been removed, and with such a fast reproduction rate every catch you make really counts.








# Centrestage Theatre gearing up for 2022



For now, here are a couple more recommendations for your summer reading list.




